The goods and services shown below are those we can provide to our customers. You may choose only the items you desire. However, any funeral arrangements you select will include a charge for our basic services and overhead. If legal or other requirements mean you must buy any items you did not specifically ask for, we will explain the reason in writing on the statement we provide describing the funeral goods and services you selected.

Cremation and Burial Plans:

All plans include receiving and transporting the deceased at any hour of the day or night within the local 30-mile service area, sheltering and refrigeration of remains for up to 14 days, local transportation to crematory or cemetery, conference with survivors to make arrangements, procurement and filing of death certificate, notification of social security and posting of obituary on our website.

Plan 1 – Direct Cremation.....\$955.

Member price...(Member Discount of \$160).....**\$795.**

Cremation with an alternative container. Cremated remains placed in standard urn.

Plan 2 – Direct Cremation with ID Viewing.....\$1,155.

Member price...(Member Discount of \$200).....**\$995.**

Same as Plan 1 but includes time for a private family viewing without embalming for a period of up to 1 hour.

This is not a general public viewing, but rather a viewing with minimal preparation of the body for next-of-kin.

Plan 3 – Direct Burial without Graveside Service.....\$1,465.

Member price...(Member Discount of \$250)**\$1,215.**

Basic cloth-covered casket, delivery of casketed remains on Monday through Friday between the hours of 9 am and 5 pm to a cemetery in the local service area. Burial time coordinated with cemetery with no family present.

Plan 4 – Direct Burial with Graveside Service.....\$1,915.

Member price...(Member Discount of \$300).....**\$1,615.**

Same as Plan 3 but includes coordination of a graveside service.

Plan 5 – Full Mortuary Services with Basic Casket.....\$2,915.

Member price...(Member Discount of \$400).....**\$2,515.**

Basic cloth-covered casket and the following services as requested: embalming, dressing, cosmetology, use of contracted chapel or viewing facilities, coordinating services at contracted venue Monday through Friday between the hours of 9 am and 5 pm, handling of flowers, delivery to cemetery in the local service area. This plan does not include a procession or graveside service.

Plan 6 – Full Mortuary Services with Metal Casket.....\$3,415.

Member price...(Member Discount of \$500).....**\$2,915.**

Same as Plan 5 but uses a basic 20-gauge metal casket

Plan 7 – Aquamation.....\$1,795.

Member price...(Member Discount of \$205).....**\$1,590.**

Includes transportation of deceased to and from Portland, Oregon. Aquamated remains are placed in a standard urn to be returned to family.

What is not included in these plans:

The People's Memorial plans do not include: sales tax, \$70 King County Medical Examiner tax, transportation outside the 30-mile service area, ferry or bridge tolls, newspaper obituaries, honoraria for clergy, celebrant or musicians, cost of certified copies of the death certificate or other cash advance items. Transportation requiring 1 staff-person outside 30-mile service area \$3.00 per mile one-way. Transportation requiring 2 staff-people outside 30-mile service area \$4.50 per mile one-way. Transportation involving a ferry \$150 per round trip, \$350 per round trip to the San Juan Islands. Transport for autopsy or Medical Examiner extra.

Basic Service Fee:

Basic Services of Funeral Director, Staff and Overhead.....\$ 600.

Our services include: conducting the arrangements conference; planning the funeral; consulting with family and clergy; shelter of remains; preparing and filing of necessary authorizations and permits; coordinating with the cemetery, crematory, or other third parties. In addition, this fee includes a proportionate share of our basic overhead costs. This fee for our basic services and overhead will be added to the total cost of the funeral arrangements you choose if you desire arrangements other than plans 1-7 unless otherwise referenced.

The Co-op Funeral Home is proud to be certified by the **Green Burial Council** to provide green burial services. Green burial is the burial of unembalmed remains in a fully biodegradable casket or shroud with no concrete grave liner or vault. We can arrange for green burial at the natural burial ground or cemetery of your choice. Plans 3 or 4 can be handled as green burials with a cloth shroud substituted for the cloth-covered casket at no extra cost. We also offer other green burial options including wicker or seagrass caskets as well as a basic wood casket.

Carbon Neutral Cremation

The Co-op Funeral Home may be the first funeral home in the US to provide carbon neutral cremation for all cremations we handle. In order to offset the greenhouse gases produced by this process, we invest in renewable solar and wind energy through the **Bonneville Environmental Foundation**, a northwest non-profit organization affiliated with the Bonneville Power Administration. We also make a donation to **American Forests** to plant a tree, honoring each family we serve and investing in the health of our planet.
