However, any funeral arrangements you select will include a charge for our basic services and overhead. If legal or other requirements mean you must buy any items you did not specifically ask for, we will explain the reason in writing on the statement we provide describing the funeral goods and services you selected.

### Cremation & Aquamation

Cremation is a method of final disposition by which heat, through the use of flame, is applied to break down our organic matter, reducing it to our basic elements and dried bone fragments. This is the most common form of final disposition that The Co-op Funeral Home offers our customers.

Our direct cremation packages include an alternative container in place of a casket. Alternative containers encase the body before cremation and can be made of materials like fiberboard or composition materials. The alternative containers we provide have a fiberboard bottom and cardboard top, which look similar to a butter dish.

Our direct cremation packages also include a simple plastic container to hold the cremated remains after cremation. This gives you the opportunity to opt out of choosing an urn or allows you to take your time to find something really special.

Aquamation, otherwise known as Alkaline Hydrolysis, is a more environmentally friendly alternative to the flame based cremation that instead uses heated water, pressure and alkalinity to help break down our organic matter that is then processed to reduce it to a soft powder.

Otherwise known as PMA's <i>Plan 1</i> or <i>Simple Cremation</i> . This Plan includes an alternative container and standard black, plastic urn. No viewing or additional services included.		
<b>Cremation with ID Viewing</b>	<b>\$1205</b>	<b>\$1350</b>
Otherwise known as PMA's <i>Plan 2</i> . Same as a direct cremation with the addition of a private viewing at our care facility in Kent, WA for up to 1 hour. This is not a viewing open to the public, rather a simple viewing with minimal preparation of the decedent for the next of kin. Your loved one will be placed on a cot dressed up with a pillow and blanket. This does not include embalming or dressing, but these are optional items that can be added if you choose.

Aquamated remains are placed in a standard black, plastic urn, no viewing or additional services included.		
<b>Aquamation with Viewing</b>	<b>\$1665</b>	<b>\$1855</b>
Same as a direct Aquamation with the addition of a private viewing at our care facility in Kent, WA for up to 1 hour. This is not a viewing open to the public, rather a simple viewing with minimal preparation of the decedent for the next of kin. This does not include embalming or dressing, but these are optional items that can be added if you choose.		

## Terramation

Terramation, otherwise known as human composting, is a relatively new process for final disposition. The process is the act of gently transforming human remains into life-giving soil. A body is laid in with a mixture of alfalfa, straw and sawdust and given plenty of air flow to allow the organic matter to naturally break down over the course of 30 - 90 days. At the end of the process the next of kin is presented with nutrient rich bags of soil. You may choose any amount of soil you would like. Should you choose not to receive the entire amount of composted remains, they will be scattered on a piece of land in need of revitalization. This land is maintained by our partners at *Return Home* in Auburn, WA.

Terramated remains are placed in burlap sacks in weight increments of the next of kin's choosing, no viewing or additional services included.		
<b>Terramation with a Laying In Ceremony</b>	<b>\$4375</b>	<b>\$5450</b>
Same as a direct terramation with the addition of 2 hours usage of the Return Home facility for a gathering and in-person goodbye. This viewing can accommodate up to 50-60 people with the next of kin being able to include personal, organic materials in the container to be gently transformed into compost along with the decedent.

#### **Direct Burial without Graveside Service**

Otherwise known as PMA's *Plan 3*. This plan includes a basic cloth-covered casket, delivery of casketed remains Monday through Friday between the hours of 9 am and 5 pm to a cemetery within the 30 mile service radius. Burial date and time will be coordinated with the cemetery with no next of kin present for the burial.

#### **Burial with a Graveside Service**

Otherwise known as PMA's *Plan 4*. This plan includes a basic cloth-covered casket, delivery of casketed remains Monday through Friday between the hours of 9 am and 5 pm to a cemetery within the 30 mile service radius. Burial date and time will be coordinated with the cemetery with the next of kin present for a graveside service or witnessed burial.

The following funeral service plans do not include the cost for a graveside service. These plans are meant to be open ended, allowing you to choose either cremation or burial to follow your service. Otherwise known as PMA's <i>Plan 5</i> . This plan includes a basic cloth-covered casket and the following services: embalming, dressing, use of parlor at our Queen Anne location for viewing or funeral services Monday through Friday between the hours of 9 am and 5 pm, transportation by van, handling of flowers, This plan does <u>not</u> include clergy/officiant or the flowers arrangements. The cloth casket can be cremated or buried.		
<b>Full Mortuary Service with Metal Casket</b>	<b>\$3125</b>	<b>\$3465</b>
Otherwise known as PMA's <i>Plan 6</i> , this is the same service as <i>Plan 5</i> , but with a basic 20-gauge metal casket. You may substitute the metal casket for our wood rental casket if you are adding cremation following your service.		
<b>Full Mortuary Service at your own venue</b>	<b>\$2385</b>	<b>\$2676</b>
This packaged plan includes a basic cloth-covered casket and the following services: embalming, dressing, use of staff for funeral at your house of worship Monday through Friday between the hours of 9 am and 5 pm, transportation by van, handling of flowers, This plan does <u>not</u> include clergy/officiant or flowers, cremation or graveside following the service. A credit equal to the cost of the cloth casket will be deducted if you prefer to upgrade the casket.		

### Burial/Graveside or Cremation add-on for funeral service plans

This is a round trip fee to the venue and/or cemetery by a traditional funeral hearse.

This is our standard mode of transport. This is a round trip fee to the venue and/or cemetery. Can also be added as an extra vehicle to transport flowers depending on availability.

This is a cash advance service and has a minimum of three motorcycles or motorized vehicles. Details and coordination will be communicated by the Funeral Director.

**Use of facilities and staff for Funeral Ceremony** **\$740** **\$870**

The Co-op Funeral Home is located inside of the Queen Anne Baptist Church which has a parlor available on the ground floor for casketed services. The parlor is available for up to 4 hours and will be staffed by the Co-op Funeral Home. This includes coordination support, set up and tear down of the space. Max capacity 50 people. May change due to covid restrictions.

**Use of facilities and staff for Memorial Service** **\$425** **\$500**

Use of the Queen Anne Baptist Church chapel or parlor for memorial service (no casket present). Space rental is available for up to 4 hours and will be staffed by the Co-op Funeral Home. This includes coordination support, set up and tear down of the space. Max capacity for the Chapel is 40. Max cap for the Parlor is 50 people. May change due to covid restrictions.

**Staffing for Ceremony at venue of your choice** **\$425** **\$500**

The staffing needed if you choose to have a casketed funeral service at your own house of worship.

**Weekend Viewing or Ceremony Service Fee** **\$400** **\$470**

Overtime fees for a service on a weekend or holiday.

**Use of Staff & Equipment for Graveside Service** **\$400** **\$470**

Included in Plan 4 - Direct Burial with Graveside Service. This fee includes Funeral Director staff for a graveside service or witnessed burial. Funeral home staff are required to remain at the cemetery until family has departed and the transfer of custody of remains is completed.

**Additional Hour for Viewing or Service** **\$125** **\$150**

If more time is needed in the parlor or chapel for a service, we can accommodate.

**Reception in Parlor After Memorial Service** **\$190** **\$225**

Use of the parlor after a memorial service for up to 1 hour for a social reception.

**ID Viewing or Facilities for Religious Preparations** **\$300** **\$350**

Included in Plan 2 - Cremation with ID Viewing. Includes a private viewing at our care facility in Kent, WA for up to 1 hour. This is not a viewing open to the public, rather a simple viewing with minimal preparation of the decedent for the next of kin. Your loved one will be placed on a cot dressed up with a pillow and blanket. Alternatively this time may also be used for spiritual or religious preparation of the body or a bathing ceremony. Details and coordination will be communicated by the Funeral Director.

**Embalming** **\$330** **\$388**

Except in certain circumstances, embalming is not required by law. Embalming may be necessary, however, if you select certain funeral arrangements, such as a funeral with a viewing, or when cosmetology is requested. Embalming may also be necessary if the body is going to be traveling an extensive distance and cold storage is not feasible. If you do not want embalming, you have the right to choose an arrangement that does not require you to pay for it, such as direct cremation or direct burial.

**Autopsy Repair** **\$125** **\$150**

In the event that the decedent has had an autopsy and a viewing is requested by the next of kin.

This add-on is available only with Cremations or Aquamations with a viewing and includes being present to witness the placement of your loved one into the cremation or aquamation vessel following your viewing. Once the cremation or aquamation has begun, all parties must take their leave and pick up the final remains from The Co-op Funeral Home office at a later date.

Life comes at us fast, sometimes our schedules demand quicker movement, in the event you find yourself in this situation, we can accommodate. Expedited Cremations are done within five business days from the date we receive our cremation permit.

If you've experienced the loss of someone under the age of 1 year old, the total cost is reduced from the member pricing for cremation listed on page 3.

This includes our basic services of funeral director and staff, Transfer of Remains to Funeral Home, refrigeration for up to 14 days, filing of death certificate and local transportation to a cemetery. This does not include a casket, graveside service or witnessed burial. Before purchasing your own casket please consult with your funeral director for proper shipping address & instructions.

This charge includes: basic services of staff & overhead, transportation of remains into the care of The Co-op Funeral Home, Embalming, and transportation to SeaTac airport. Not included: airline fees, international consulate paperwork, document translation services, casket and airtray.

**Receiving Remains from Another Funeral Home** **\$845** **\$975**

This charge includes: basic services of staff & overhead and transportation of remains from a local airport into the care of the funeral home.

**International Consulate Fees** **\$300** **\$353**

This fee covers communication, paperwork and coordination with international consulates to adhere to international laws and regulations for the transportation of a decedent. If translations for legal documents or apostilles are required, there may be an additional fee.

Available only within the 30 mile service radius. Delivery of cremated or aquamated remains, death certificates and property.

All packages include 14 days of sheltering and refrigeration. Additional charges begin on day 15. After 10 additional days, storage fees are capped at \$500 per month or portion thereof.

During the summer months, The Co-op Funeral Home staff will hold vigil and scatter cremated or aquamated remains in The Sound. Green burial is the burial of unembalmed remains in a fully biodegradable casket or shroud with no concrete grave liner or vault. We can arrange for green burial at the natural burial ground or cemetery of your choice. Plans 3 or 4 can be handled as green burials with a cloth shroud substituted for the cloth-covered casket at no extra cost. We also offer other green burial options including wicker or seagrass caskets as well as a basic wood casket.
